# Welcome to Charrington's Easter Bunny Egg Hunt!

The egg hunt is unsupervised and hosted simply on our public footpaths with 10 stations on a roughly circular route. They are well marked but do occasionally leave and come back to the farm. The route will take about 40 mins to 1 hour depending upon how long your legs are!

Please take extra care with pets and children in the areas closest to the reservoir. We have an optional diverted route to avoid the worst muddy puddles but please wear suitable footwear (no open toes) and keep an eye on little ones and pets.

Please do not park on the farm or block people's entrances – this is a walking to and walking from the farm event to promote our local footpaths. You might like to get extra refreshment by making your route via one of our local pubs that serve Charrington's: The Hop Bine (Petteridge), The Halfway House (between Horsmonden and Brenchley), Gray's Café, The Little Bull (Brenchley) or even a bit further for the Chequers (Lamberhurst)

Please take a map and a basket to collect the chocs as you go round. There is a tasting table at station 3 where you can even ring the fog horn for cider and order for free home delivery. If anything is getting low or empty please let us know either by phone or text 07919413104. The stations will be replenished through Sunday until they run out! This is definitely a WIGIG event!
